

Young Peoples' Construction of Identities in the Early 21st Century

In 2010 the Jaan Tõnisson Institute assisted professor-emeritus Alistair Ross from the *London Metropolitan University Institute for Policy Studies in Education* to conduct student focus-groups interviews in Tallinn schools. The aim of the study was to gather information about the students' constructing their Europe-identities in the new European Union member states and accession states.
