

## **Consumer Education in the content of compulsory education**

Since 2000 the Civic Education Centre together with the Estonian Board of Consumer Protection and Tallinn Pedagogical University in cooperation with the Nordic Countries' Consumer Protection Institutions and Hedmark University (Norway) has been exploring the space for Consumer Education in the National Curriculum of Estonia. During the years 2000 - 2003 dealing with the consumer education was broadened taking place in three closely related projects already. So far the analyses of Estonian National Curriculum was revised for exploring space for consumer education in it. Sample lessons of consumer education were created and the basic concept for teacher training in consumer education was developed.
