

Cooperation project "Pluralism and Tolerance in the Societies with Ethnic Minorities"

The project, aimed to support integration processes in the society was carried out in 1997 in cooperation with King Baoudouin Foundation (Belgium). The participants of the project were 12 Russian schools headmasters from different regions of Estonia representing as well as public schools and as well private schools. During the two two-days and one three-days seminar the participants brainstormed and analyzed the situation of Estonian education for Russian speaking schools.

During the project the participants there was worked out an education-policy document, which was presented to the high educational officials and members of Riigikogu.

Much interest was paid to the problems of implementation of the New National Curriculum in the Russian speaking schools. By the participants of the project were elaborated three different variants of curriculum for Russian schools in Estonia.
