

Enhancement of awareness about diversity of cultures and provision of equal opportunities for obtaining social and learning skills in international cooperation

In January 2009 in Tallinn there was launched a UNESCO financed international research project (4641900004ENA) about the values of 16 - 18 years old people. The international team consists of representatives of Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Finland and United States.



The Pilot Study was carried out in Estonia, Latvia, Finland, Azerbaijan, USA states Indiana and Colorado. The results of the international Pilot Study were finalized in December 2009 and they are as a pdf file accessible in English on this site here. The project was financially supported by the Estonian Ministry of Education and Research and by the Constitutional Rights Foundation (Chicago, USA).

The study was introduced by the Head of the Jaan Tõnisson Institute Civic Education Centre in 2009 in Ohrid in Macedonia on the seminar of European and American civic educators - members of the Deliberating in Democracy (DID) project, in Nanjing (China) on the World Meeting of UNESCO Chairholders and during the NECE conference workshop in Vilnius. In 2010 the study was introduced in Glasgow, Scotland on the meeting of DARE network.
