

Estonian Civics Teachers Survey

Financed by the Civic Education Centre (Calabasas, USA) and supported by Indiana University a survey of Estonian Civics teachers was arranged in 2000. The aim of the survey was to collect representative data about the features of Estonian Civics teachers staff. Survey contains for instance information about the age, gender, pre-service training of the teachers and about the preferences of teaching methods and content areas as well. The questionnaires were developed by the Jaan Tõnisson Institute, assessed by the Evaluation Centre of Indiana University, sent out to the teachers and later scanned also in Indiana University.

The results of the survey were presented on the Baltic-American Civics Conference in Riga in 2001. The data collected is later widely used in different occasions
