



ESTONIAN DEVELOPMENT COOPERATION

Helping to integrate the Armenian minority into Georgian society

The objective of the project is the increased participation of the Armenian minority in Georgian civic society as well as policy and decision making process. Although the integration process of the minorities after the democratic revolution in 2003 has been rapid and successful, there is still a lot to be done, as the minorities are still underrepresented in Georgia. The project aims at creating the capacity among the Armenian minority to form civic society organisations (NGOs) as well as to conduct negotiations with regional and national powers and to influence respective policies. Respective trainings will be conducted in Georgia and a study trip to get acquainted with the Estonian experience will be conducted. Additionally, an Armenian guideline for setting up NGOs in Georgia highlighting the legal regulations will be compiled.
